

A small, round shouldered dreadnaught with Venetian cutaway, Brazilian rosewood * multi-scaled fretboard, 14/24 fret, Brazilian rosewood back and sides, Koa bindings, Adirondack red spruce top, Cuban mahogany neck, Paua abalone inlay detailing. Light finger style action. This guitar is surprisingly balanced, full, clear and deep, especially for its size. It has rich harmonics and tremendous sustain endorsing the reputation Brazilian rosewood and Adirondack red spruce have earned.
