

This little Engleman spruce and Indian rosewood guitar was created to capture a customer's interest in a very small body guitar. Niki is a short scale steel string guitar, tuned as if it were a normal guitar capoed on the third fret. Some refer to this as a Terz Guitar, after an early classical instrument of the same scale length and tuning. Bright, clear and fast, its powerful voice can punch through and above the background whether with rhythm, lead or finger style.
